



DON'T GET BARRED!

Unlawful Presence will now apply to students & exchange visitors (J, F or M visas)

What is Unlawful presence?

Unlawful presence occurs when a visa holder remains in the U.S. after their visa period has ended or a person is in the U.S. without having a valid visa or authorization to be here.

Starting **August 9** unlawful presence will start to apply to students and exchange visitors who have overstayed their visas and remained beyond the grace period.

DAY 1+

On first day of overstay you will start to accrue unlawful presence time



DAY 180+

Receive a **three year ban** from returning to the U.S.



DAY 365+

Receive a **ten year ban** from returning to the U.S.

Be sure to have a solid plan for your departure within the allowed timeframe for your visa.
